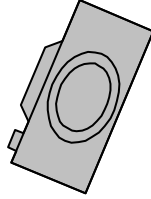

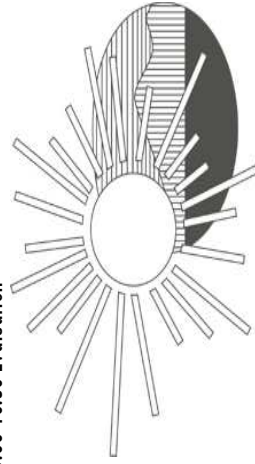

Fr. Jack Gallagher is a priest in the Congregation of Saint Basil (CSB). He began his teaching career in 1955 at a high school in Ontario and has been teaching at a variety of colleges and universities ever since. In 1967 Fr. Gallagher received his S.T.D. in Moral Theology. He has authored several articles and books on a variety of moral and ethical issues. After serving as president at Newman Theological College, Fr. Jack accepted a position as an adjunct professor at the University of St. Thomas in Houston Texas.

Dr. David Goa is the director of the Chester Ronning Centre at the University of Alberta's Augustana Campus. He built the program for the study of culture through his field research work over thirty years at the Royal Alberta Museum. He lectures widely and is the author of numerous books and scholarly articles and is a regular contributor in the media. Dr. Goa will discuss the Cardinal Virtues with an Interfaith Perspective on Morality.
